reviewed the statements and arguments of counsel, and otherwise being sufficiently advised in
the premises,

FINDS AND ORDERS THAT:

1. Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction [Doc. \_\_\_ ] should be and is hereby

GRANTED.

2. Defendants, their agents, officers, and employees, and their requirements that Plaintiffs

provide, in their health insurance plan, FDA-approved contraceptive methods, sterilization

procedures, and patient education and counseling for women with reproductive capacity,

including the substantive requirement imposed in 42 U.S.C. § 300gg-13(a)(4) any and all

regulations implementing that provision with respect to Plaintiffs, the applicability of the

penalties found in 26 U.S.C. §§ 4980D & 4980H and 29 U.S.C. § 1132, and any determination

that the requirements are applicable to Plaintiffs, are ENJOINED from any application or

enforcement thereof against Plaintiffs..

3. No bond shall be required as there is no prejudice to the Defendants.

4. Said injunction shall expire 90 days from the date of the entry of an order on the merits of

Plaintiffs' challenges.
