**AGREED ORDER TO STAY LITIGATION**

WHEREFORE, the Court has scheduled an evidentiary hearing on Plaintiffs’ Motion for a Temporary Injunction in this matter for July 24, 25, and 26, along with earlier dates for the parties to exchange witness and exhibit lists and a prehearing conference;

WHEREFORE, on June 25, 2024, the Oklahoma Supreme Court issued its ruling on the Attorney General’s Application to Assume Original Jurisdiction for Writ of Mandamus and Declaratory Relief in the matter of *Drummond v. Oklahoma Statewide Virtual Charter School Board*, No. 121,694, 2024 OK 53 (“*Drummond* action”); and


WHEREFORE, all parties in this matter have reached agreement to stay all proceedings in this case through at least February 1, 2025, including the hearing on Plaintiffs’ Motion for a Temporary Injunction, Defendants’ responses to Plaintiffs’ First Amended and Supplemental Petition, and all discovery, pending appellate review in the *Drummond* action, in light of Defendant St. Isidore of Seville Catholic Virtual School’s agreement not to accept charter-school funding from the State or open to students as a charter school during the 2024–25 school year;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all proceedings in this matter, including all events currently scheduled in connection with Plaintiffs’ Motion for a Temporary Injunction,

Defendants' responses to Plaintiffs' First Amended and Supplemental Petition, and all discovery shall be stayed effective this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 2024; and


IT IS FURTHER noted that by agreement St. Isidore shall not open as an Oklahoma charter school during the 2024–25 school year or receive charter-school funding from the State of Oklahoma for the same. St. Isidore preserves all appellate rights to challenge the Oklahoma Supreme Court's June 25, 2024 ruling and potentially open as a charter school or receive charter-school funding after the 2024–25 school year; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, after February 1, 2025, the Court shall promptly schedule a status conference to discuss with the parties whether the stay should continue.


